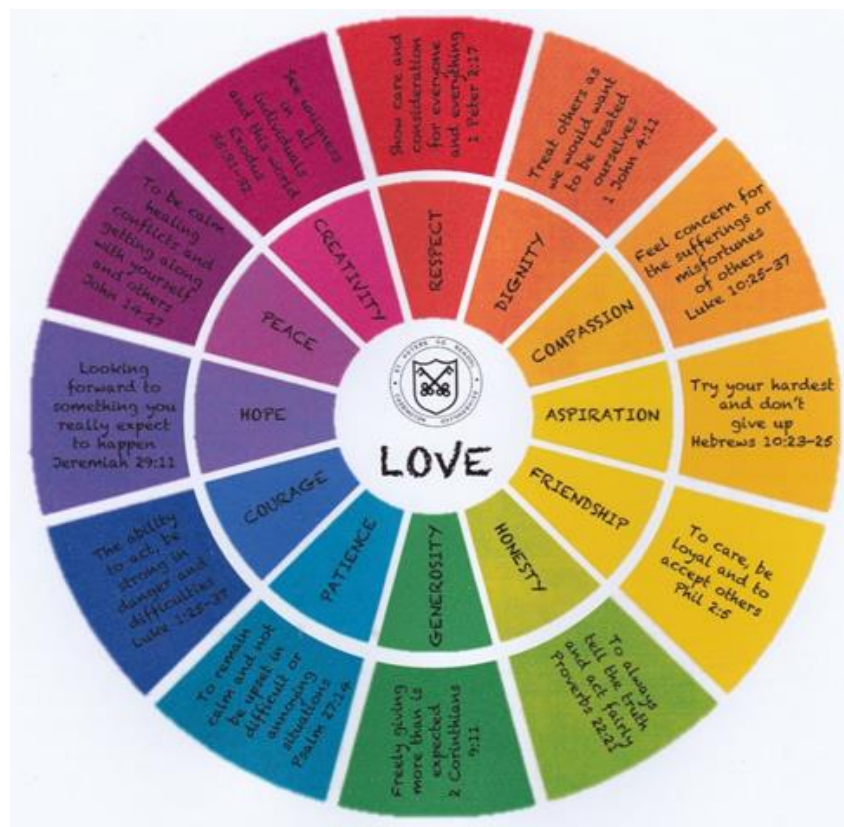


# Examples of how St Peter's CE Primary School live our Vision and Values

<p><b>Patience</b> To remain calm and not be upset in difficult or annoying situations Psalm 27:14</p>	<p>Behaviour policy is centred around the values and how we patiently talk through them for all behaviour</p>
<p><b>Generosity</b> Freely giving more than is expected 2 Corinthians 9:11</p>	<p>Learning and adapting teaching to Google Classroom Sharing best practice with other schools e.g. Google Classroom Lending Chromebooks so that every child could access online learning</p>
<p><b>Honesty</b> To always tell the truth and act fairly Proverbs 22:21</p>	<p>Early intervention from nursery/reception. Getting it right for the child early Conversations with parents—nipping it in the bud Having the hard conversations – short term discomfort for the child’s long-term benefit</p>
<p><b>Friendship</b> To care, be loyal and to accept others Phil 2:5</p>	<p>Supporting other staff Supporting parents during lockdown—phone calls as needed. Teachers kept logs of individual needs and support</p>
<p><b>Aspiration</b> Try your hardest and don’t give up Hebrews 10:23-25</p>	<p>Providing at least 4 lessons daily on Google Classroom. (In top 6% of state schools that achieved this during lockdown) in 2020 Bespoke program of learning for vulnerable learning during lockdown</p>
<p><b>Compassion</b> Feel concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others Luke 10:25-37</p>	<p>Focus on children who struggle so every child has the opportunity to succeed. KS1 small writing group for struggling children led by teacher (1:3) SEN live 1:1 daily support lessons</p>
<p><b>Dignity</b> Treat others as we would want to be treated ourselves 1 John 4:11</p>	<p>Inviting other schools to observe our practice and being a critical friend Understanding the individual journeys through Covid for our children and their families</p>
<p><b>Respect</b> Show care and consideration for everyone and everything 1 Peter 2:17</p>	<p>Treating everyone the same, being fair through our values ‘People Who Inspire Us’ initiative</p>
<p><b>Creativity</b> Show uniqueness in all individuals and this world. Exodus 35:31-32</p>	<p>Making virtual online opportunities in lockdown—sports day; collective worship; easter bonnet parade Teachers encouraging children to present work in different ways</p>
<p><b>Peace</b> To be calm healing conflicts and getting along with yourself and others John 14:27</p>	<p>Making school a safe, happy place for the children to be. Model peaceful conflict resolution for children Training from external agencies to provide support for the most vulnerable with recognition from VSLAC for this.</p>
<p><b>Hope</b> Looking forward to something you really want to happen Jeremiah 29:11</p>	<p>Well-rounded education with all subjects covered both in lockdown and on return to school. St Peter’s largely maintained progress measures through all year groups. Where gaps identified, personalised plan of intervention is in place</p>
<p><b>Courage</b> The ability to act, be strong in danger and difficulties Luke 1:25-37</p>	<p>Taking on new roles during lockdown. Staff were very flexible and proactive in taking on challenges and teaching in different classes. Learning new systems of presenting learning Taking a leap of faith in returning to school during Covid (anxiety)</p>

<p><b>Compassion</b> Feel concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others Luke 10:25-37</p>	<p>We wrote letters to the residents of Churchfields during lockdown. We are kind We are look after bugs and make houses for them</p>
<p><b>Dignity</b> Treat others as we would want to be treated ourselves 1 John 4:11</p>	<p>We lead collective worship on Thursdays We forgive people when they do wrong</p>
<p><b>Respect</b> Show care and consideration for everyone and everything 1 Peter 2:17</p>	<p>We treat others the way we would like to be treated. We look after the St Peter's fish We respect our school property If someone else is talking, we listen to them</p>
