## LAST MINUTE REMINDERS FOR YENWORTHY

### On Monday morning:

- Please make sure your child has a rucksack, with a snack, a water bottle, and packed lunch and any NON-ELECTRICAL entertainment—this will be with them on the bus.
- Please give any medication to Emily. It will need to be clearly labelled with name & dose, and you will also need to complete a consent form.
- Please give any mints for the journey to Mrs Humphris. (Please make sure the mints are labelled with your child's name). The children should have no other sweets.
- Please remember that it is normal for a child to be a bit wobbly before we leave. They will have an amazing time so please keep telling them this, and try not to get upset yourself!

### Communication:

- We will let school know when we arrive on Monday afternoon and they will send out a message.
- There is very little service at the lodge but we will try and put a few photos onto the Willow class webpage.
- We will let school know once we have left on Friday with an ETA for home.

### General reminders:

- Yenworthy have waterproof jackets and trousers, welly boots and day rucksacks all available to borrow.
- Prohibited items! Please do not send your child with any snacks / sweets or electronic devices. We also can't take any aerosol tins, so if your child uses deodorant they will need a stick deodorant instead of spray.

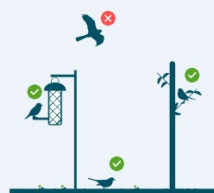
1 Get your free guide and stock up on supplies, with 20% off and free delivery on food and feeders at the RSPB shop.

3 Tell us what you saw (even if that's nothing at all)! You can submit your results online or by post.



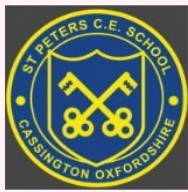
