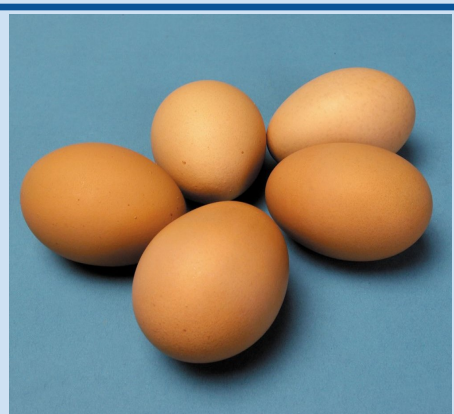
Fresh eggs
