### **Key Concepts:**

- Florence Nightingale was a nurse who was born in 1820
- The Crimean war was fought in Crimea in Eastern Europe. It started in 1853 and ended in 1856.
- Mary Seacole was a nurse and business woman who was born in Jamaica in 1805, her father was a Scottish soldier and her mother was a Jamaican 'doctress' (or nurse).
- Mary set up a place for soldiers to stay, eat and buy supplies and called it 'The British Hotel'. She made frequent trips to the battlefields to nurse the injured soldiers.
- Florence set up the first professional nursing school in the world in St Thomas' Hospital. She named it London's Nightingale school of Nursing.
