Who was Guy Fawkes? Why do we celebrate bonfire night? Why do we have fireworks? What date is Guy Fawkes night each year? Who was the king at the time? Why did Guy Fawkes want to blow up the Houses of Parliament? Why was Guy Fawkes punished? Who helped Guy

### Key Concepts:

- In 1605 Guy Fawkes and his friends wanted to blow up the Houses of Parliament in London, where the King and his leaders were.
- Guy Fawkes and his 13 friends wanted somebody else to rule the country.
- Guy Fawkes was a Catholic and he didn't believe in the Protestant faith of the King James I.
- Guy Fawkes and his friends filled the basement of The Houses of Parliament with gunpowder and planned to blow it up.
- Fortunately, Guy Fawkes was caught before this happened and nobody was hurt.
- In England we celebrate Bonfire Night on 5th November to remember how Guy Fawkes was caught and sent to jail.
