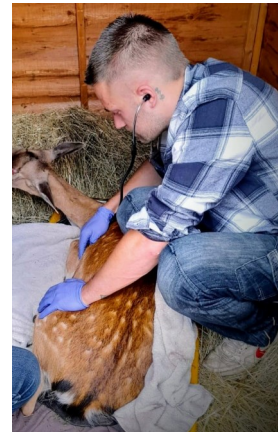


# LUKE WACLAWEK

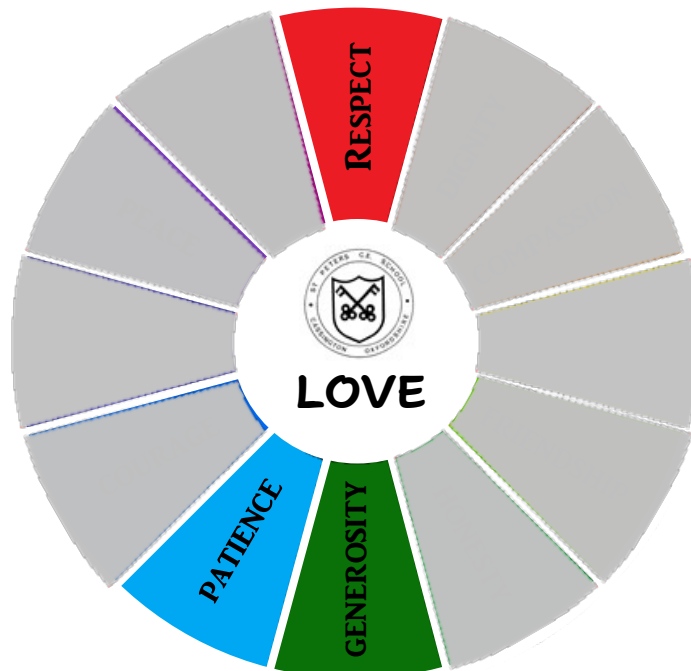
