The curriculum map is a guide for how long each year group should spend on each unit. Ample time is allotted to units to enable in-depth study of every topic. Teachers will use formative assessment to make the schemes work for them, adding extra time where necessary for topics that need most attention and adapting other learning accordingly. The consolidation sections show where flexibility is accounted for within the planning. Teachers can choose when to teach each units as long as they ensure all units for both year groups are covered across a span of two academic years and reflected clearly in the appropriate terms of the class’s AB curriculum map cycle. With the mixed year group classes, often teachers will be able to teach like content simultaneously for mixed year groups however it may be necessary on occasions for some lessons to be taught as two separate inputs, one for each year group.
