Week 5-8	<p>Teach language for talking Chinese on the telephone.</p> <p>Review tones in the context of the numbers and the difference in pronunciation for the number 1.</p> <p>Using a pretend telephone, students review a selection of dialogues containing language taught to students earlier in KS2 so they can have conversations in Chinese on the telephone (e.g. asking how each other are, people’s ages, about their families, birthdays etc).</p> <p>Learn to write the numbers six and seven 六, 七 as a way of reviewing basic strokes and stroke order.</p>	Oral and written accuracy.
