		X-Curricular	Essential Resources
Week 15-16	<p>Learn the rule for creating numbers from 11-19 in the context of the 12 Zodiac Animals.</p> <p>Pupils learn about the Chinese Zodiac story and why the cat and dog don't get along.</p> <p>Teach the word 年 meaning "year" to say the year of different animals and also to review the numbers.</p> <p>Learn the idea of 'pinyin linkwords' by drawing on creative methods of learning through Chineasy while learning the zodiac animals. They should already know 'horse' and 'tiger' from 'mama huhu' (meaning 'so-so'). Make students aware of pronunciation of 蛇 (shé) as opposed to 十 (shí).</p>	<p>Oral accuracy. Phonics. Week 17	<p>Learn what pinyin is and why it is essential for learning to speak Chinese.</p> <p>Know what an initial and final is.</p> <p>Introduce the 'pinyin cheat sheet' and show students how to use it by using the sheet to work out the sounds of:</p> <p>The cheeky three: "j, q, x" (do these first)</p> <p>And the slippery seven: "zh, ch, sh, r, z, c, s" (do these second)</p>	<p>Oral accuracy. Phonics. Music.</p>	<p>Bpmf song (first half): https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EReU1BKtAXo</p> <p>Pinyin cheat sheet handout – make sure they are stuck in <u>the inside back cover of their exercise books</u> so they can be accessed by students quickly and easily.</p> <p>Show example of interactive pinyin poster. Place poster on classroom wall for it to remain permanently for reference. Ensure the poster is easily visible for all students.</p>
Week 18	<p>Learn the simple vowels a, o, e, i, u, ü.</p> <p>Learn the concept of how the simple vowels combine together to make compound vowels.</p> <p>Use the cheat sheet to learn and practice the Chinese compound vowels.</p>	<p>Oral accuracy. Phonics.</p>	<p>Bpmf song (second half): https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EReU1BKtAXo</p> <p>Compound vowels connect 4.</p>
