Apple Tree Cycle A	<p><u>Topic: Superheroes</u></p> <p>N - Enjoys mark making and makes purposeful marks on paper.</p> <p>N- Developing manipulation and control - moulding playdough, using a paintbrush, making marks on paper.</p> <p>N - Explores paint using fingers as well as brushes and other tools.</p> <p>N - Explores sticking using various materials and glue.</p> <p>N - Makes simple models using various construction materials</p> <p>R – Use one-handed tools and equipment including lots of practise to use scissors correctly.</p> <p>R - Begins/ continues drawing club journey. Draws with increasing detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details.</p> <p>N - Uses a tripod grip, further developing control when holding pens and pencils.</p> <p>R - Uses pens and pencils effectively to write and draw.</p> <p>R - Is beginning to plan a design before starting.</p> <p>R - Continues their Drawing Club adventures, using the pencil with increasing control to add more detail and complexity into their masterpieces.</p> <p>Artist of the term- Develops skills in painting, knowing how to use and clean their brush. Learn how to mix various colours. Selects the colours they need thoughtfully.
