Please try and encourage your child to come into the cloakroom on their own.

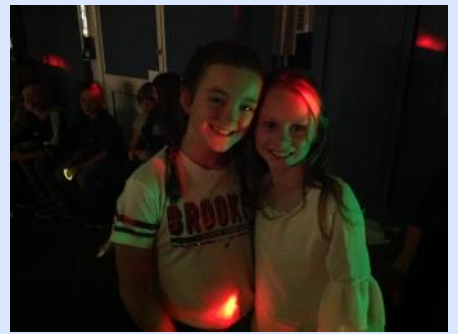

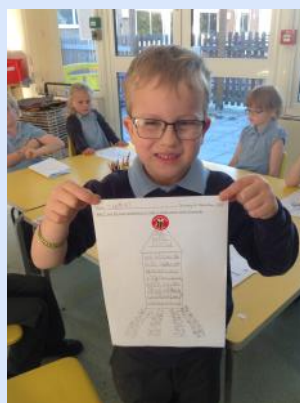
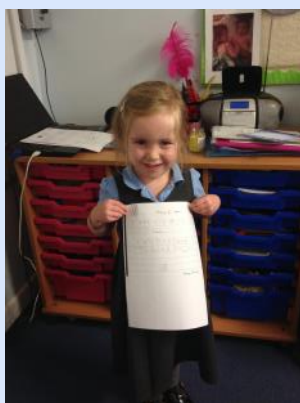
