We've had a few instances of staff arriving and not being able to park because there are cars belonging to parents and carers in the staff car park. We've also had staff blocked in at the end of the day!

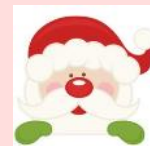

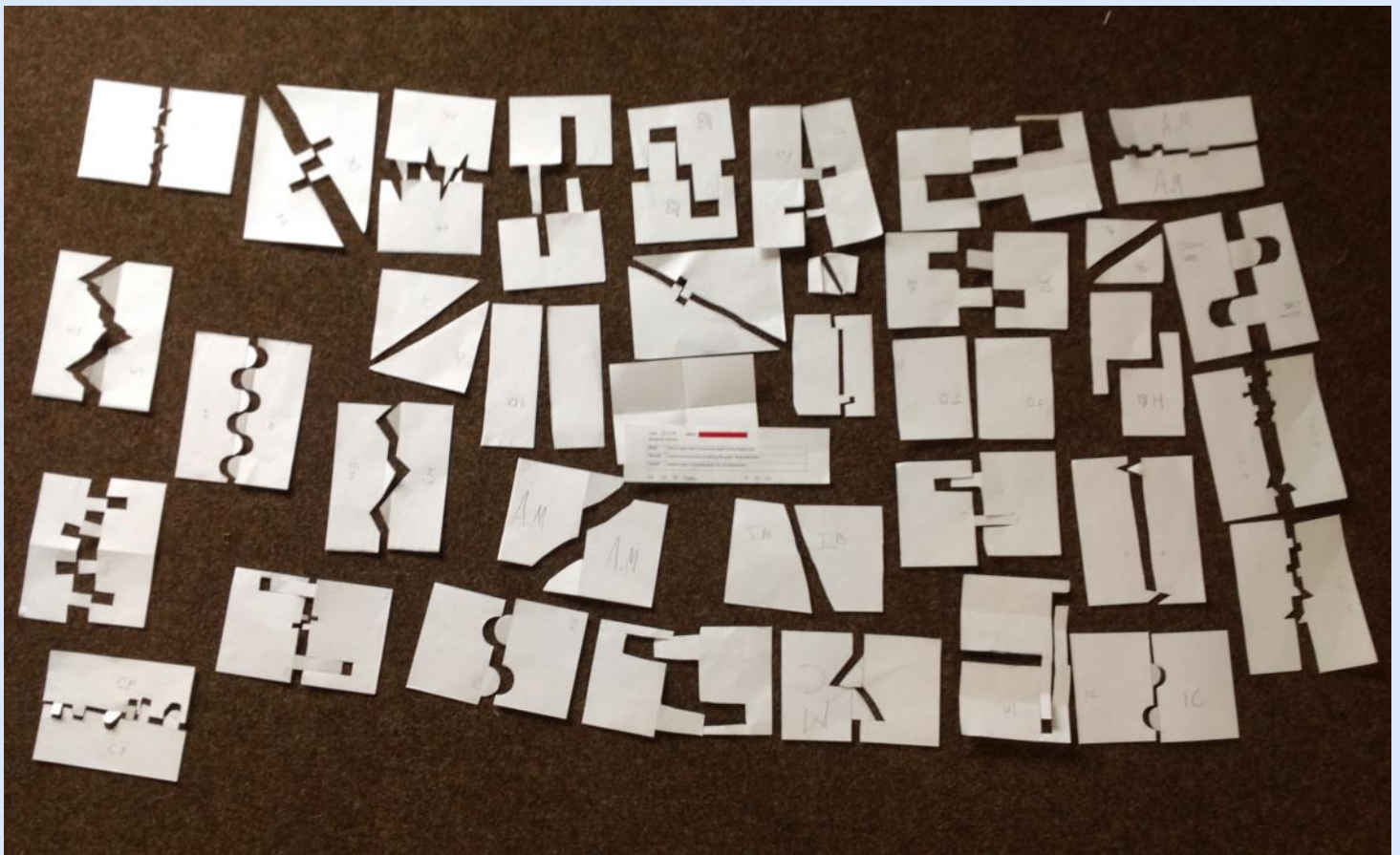
Maple Class Maths

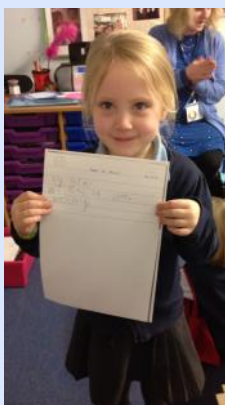
