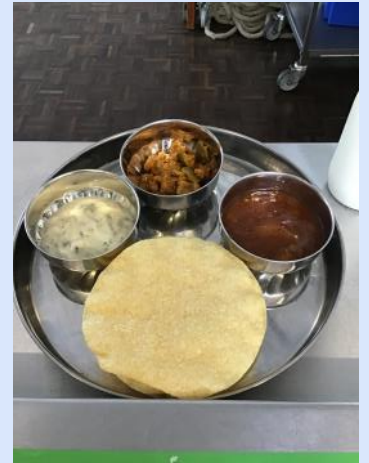
## Year 6 Date Change!
