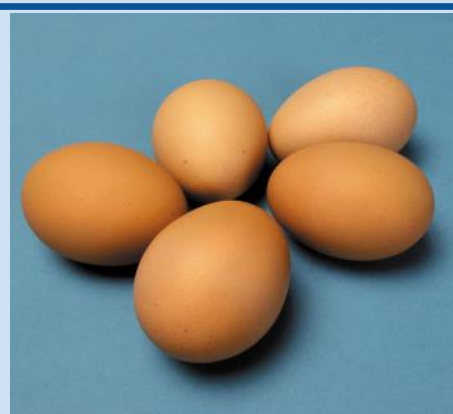
Fresh eggs

Sports Day information for Oak, Maple and Willow.

Wednesday 3rd of July is St Peter's Sports Day.

Please can children arrive at school in their PE kits (black shorts and trainers) and a t-shirt of their team colour:

Buzzards - Blue

Red kites - Red

Sparrowhawks - Yellow

Kestrels - Green

They will stay in their PE kits for the day.

The races will run in the morning at Elms road playing field. Children should be dropped off at school as normal where they will be registered. Oak, Maple and Willow Classes will then walk over to Elms road at 8:50 ready for races to start around 9am. If parents would like to spectate, they should arrive at the field for 9am and stand on the opposite side of the running track.

Once the races have been completed, the children will return to school for the rest of the morning.

The afternoon will consist of a carousel of activities and will take place on the school field. If you would like to spectate, you should arrive by the side gate (where children are collected at home time) at 1:05pm. Once the afternoon activities are completed, children will head back to classes to retrieve their belongings and will then be seen out to parents.

Please ensure children also come to school prepared for the weather. If it's sunny, sunhats and sun cream must be worn. Sun cream can be brought into school in a labelled bottle for the children to reapply themselves, but it must not be shared with other pupils. If rain is forecast, a waterproof rain coat should be worn.
